New Ing's bar 'The Staggering Wanderer' can be supplied with local Ale or Lager on tap ready to be poured out when you walk through the door.

Two of the breweries used at the Staggering Wanderer, **Tirril & Eden Brewery** are both based in the Eden Valley within a couple of miles from our door. **Hawkshead Brewery** is well-known and loved Lakeland brewery based in Stavely, less than 20 miles from the door.

Included within the price are all gas, if the Pilsner is used, glasses and commercial washer.

Tirril Brewery:

Pennine Pilsner (4.0% ABV) - comes in 9 gallon keg /88 pints of gassed cold pilsner/lager from Tirril Brewery. Brewed with Pennine water, lager malt and British top cropping yeast – then flavoured with the Czech Saaz hops, with a lemony twist and cold conditioned for that refreshingly crisp pilsner taste. **Price £162**

Old Faithful (4.0% ABV) - a light session beer with plenty of Goldings aroma hops, a blond classic. Price £138

Red Barn (4.4% ABV) - a stronger beer with Munich and crystal malts giving it a ruby red glow. Again, it is brewed not to be too heavy and has plenty of Goldings aroma. **Price £138**
